Breakfast will be served daily during our before care program.

Breakfast starts at 7:00am and will end at 8:30 am. Your student must be signed in before 8:30 am to receive breakfast. You must tell Mrs. Bresee that you would like your child to have breakfast.

Breakfast items will include Bagels, Cereal, Pancakes or French Toast Sticks. Milk or Juice is included in the price. There will not be a price reduction if your child does not choose all items offered. This is a single serving and there will be no seconds available.

# Paying for Hot Lunch and Breakfast

#### **Prepay in FACTS**

Your Family Portal in FACTS is set up for you to prepay funds into your child's Hot Lunch account. You will soon be getting an email invite from the Main Office. The account can be set so whenever your child's lunch account falls below \$10.00 a set amount will automatically be charged to your card on file. You will get an email alert when this happens. You can check your child's account balance in the Family Portal. Your child's account will only be charged if they have gone through the lunch line.

If you run a negative balance your child will never be denied lunch.



## Volunteer Opportunities

Volunteering in the Kitchen and Cafeteria is a wonderful way to see your children at school. You can choose to work in the kitchen prepping and serving food if that's where you are comfortable, or we will have opportunities to volunteer in the cafeteria supervising students while they are eating lunch.

To volunteer in the kitchen, we start at 10:00am cutting up the fruits and veggie cups, making salads and helping to prepare the main dish. You can choose to come for prepping or come in just to help serve starting at 11:00 or help clean the kitchen as others serve. Many hands make light work.

To volunteer to be a cafeteria helper you will work with the children helping them open their lunch items, handing out straws and napkins or just being a friendly face to help them through their day.

No matter where you decide to volunteer in our lunch program it will make an important impact on the daily lives of all our students. The children are so happy when they come to lunch and their faces just light up when they see their special person there.

We have 3 lunch periods each day. 2nd and 3rd grade eat first from 11:00-11:30, 4th and 5th will eat from 11:40-12:10 and Kindergarten and 1st grade will eat from 12:20-12:50.
